Each entry will compete within the following groups:

Grades Pre-K-2	\$25.00 gift card to Barnes & Nobles
Grades 3-5	\$50.00 gift card to Barnes & Nobles
Grades 6-8	\$75.00 gift card to Barnes & Nobles
Grades 9-12	\$100.00 gift card to Barnes & Nobles

Contest Guidelines:

- Entries for the contest should portray the theme “A Life Lesson I Have Learned as a Military-Connected Child.”
- Each student must be enrolled in Cumberland County Schools, and identified as military-connected through PowerSchool.
- Each entry must be submitted through an identified class or teacher.
- All artwork must be original. No kits, traced, copied, or altered artwork will be accepted.
- All artwork must be two dimensional drawings or paintings. Collages or three-dimensional artworks will not be accepted.
- A variety of art media may be used including watercolors, acrylics, colored markers, pen & ink, oil paints and tempera.
- Each entry must have attached (lightly with tape) on the back of the artwork an entry form completely filled out; which is attached. Entries will not be considered unless the entry form is attached, and all of the information is filled out.
- The minimum size for entries is 8 ½” x 11”. The maximum size is 12” x 16”.
- Artwork should be submitted flat and not rolled.
- Entries are submitted to my office at Central Services Suite 260 by 4:00 p.m. on April 20
