ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Graduating senior from a high school in Cumberland or Harnett Counties planning to attend either a 2 or 4 year accredited university/college fall 2019.
- 3.0 minimum GPA (**unweighted**) on a 4.0 scale at the time of submission.
- Military ID holder **OR** resident of either Spring Lake or Hope Mills (military status and address subject to verification by the school).
